

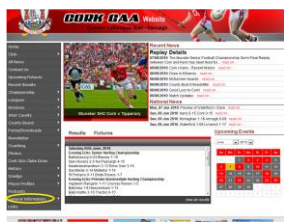

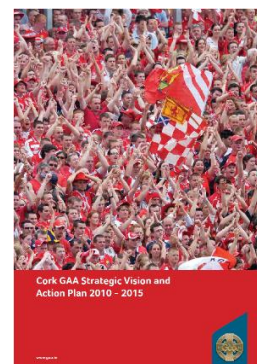

## 'Have a Go' Hurling Blitz

Over 140 boys and girls participated recently in the Scoil na Croise Naofa, Mahon "Have - a - Go" hurling blitz which was supported by Blackrock HC and Coiste Oilíúna Chorcaí. The blitz was run using the small-sided games format with a huge emphasis on participation and enjoyment. A total of 33 small sided games were held in St. Michael's Pitch in Mahon and on the school pitch. Each child received a medal which was sponsored by Blackrock G.A.A. club.

## County Board Report

Some debate took place at the Board meeting of June 22<sup>nd</sup> on the issue of spectators bringing hurleys to matches and it was decided to refer this issue back to clubs.

A curtain-raiser was announced for Sunday's replay (see details pg. 1) and an appeal was made to all patrons to come to the venue early on Sunday and have tickets purchased in advance (see [www.gaacork.ie](http://www.gaacork.ie) for ticket information). **Patrons who are not inside the barriers by 1pm on Sunday cannot be guaranteed admission to the grounds and the game will start on schedule at 2pm.**

The Cathaoirleach also reported that members of the Executive had met with Cork City Council Planning Sub-Committee regarding the re-development of Páirc Uí Chaoimh and a decision would be taken on this at the City Council's meeting on Monday, June 14<sup>th</sup>.

The next Board meeting is on June 22<sup>nd</sup>.
