As part of the

Strategic Vision and Action Plan for Gaelic Games in Cork, which is currently under development, a Youth Forum for all Juvenile Clubs in Cork was organised in Rochestown Park Hotel on November 15th last. The event was run as a series of workshops under 4 majors themes as follows: Fixtures & Structures, U12 Competitions, Post Primary Schools, Development Squads / Schools of Excellence. The attached report incorporates four related propositions which were put to various tables and includes the corresponding suggestions which emerged from the 160 Club representatives on the day. A fifth theme emerged throughout the session, namely Suggestions for Improved Coaching & Games Development and is also incorporated. Please note that the structure of the session

At the first meeting of Coiste Chontae Chorcaí for 2010, Niall Kelleher of Millstreet was ratified as Junior Football coach following the resignation of Mossie Barrett.

The starting dates for the leagues were also announced: football will begin on February 28th and hurling on March 14th. League regulations will be sent to all clubs in the near future and finalised at the next meeting. Lists of transfer applications were distributed to all delegates and will be dealt with at the next meeting.

The issue of approved helmets was also raised; according to the GAA National website it is recommended that players should only use Hurling Helmets that are IS 355 approved. This is the only standard recognised by the Association. The following brands carry this standard:
