The scheme, branded "LEE FLAG", was developed as part of the Cork GAA Strategic Plan to reward clubs who are most progressive in promoting and developing GAA in their clubs. County Games Manager Kevin O'Callaghan stated that the initiative is based on the same concept as the Green Flag for environmental best practice at primary school level. In all 28 clubs received awards on the night. As well as receiving a financial windfall, the selected clubs will now proudly display the specially commissioned flag over the next 12 months as a symbol of the high standards they work towards in their club. Further benefits will include invites to prestigious Blitzes in Croke Park, Pairc Ui Chaoimh and the other Provincial venues as well as getting first refusal on other Coiste Oilíuna organised initiatives throughout the year.
