Valleys were defeated in the first round of the Premier Intermediate Hurling Championship by Inniscarra yesterday in Cloughduv. Valleys got off to a great start going into a 3 point to no score lead after 11 minutes, with Richard Fleming getting an excellent point from play on the right wing. Valleys showed lots of endeavor but found scores hard to come by for the remainder of the half despite being backed with a fresh breeze. Valleys lead at half-time 0-4 to 0-3 with two of Inniscarra's points as a result of Valleys losing position around the middle of the field and Valleys also lost John Cottrell with a nasty Head injury before Half time.

Valleys had a point from Joe Lynch 20 seconds into the second half; Inniscarra's Colm Casey was on target again to cancel that out before he conjured up the game's crucial score, picking up a break around the 45, he left everybody in his wake and sent a brilliant shot to the top corner to make it 1-4 to 0-5. This was to be the defining score of the game as Valleys struggled to close this gap for the remainder of the game as both teams traded points.

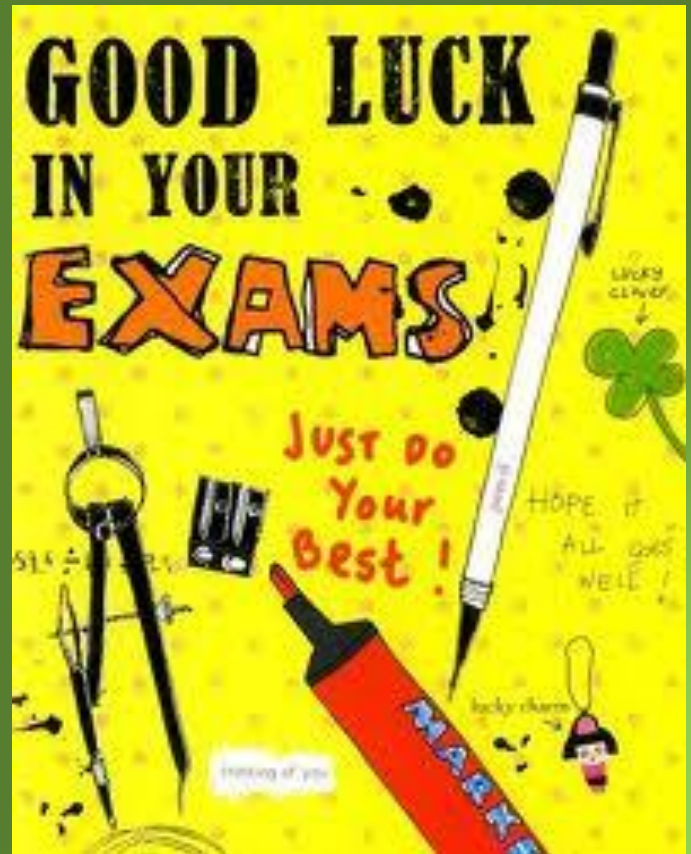
