Premier Intermediate Hurling Championship

Valley Rovers got their Hurling season back on track with an excellent victory over favourites Castelyons in Caherlag last night. Showing tremendous Rovers spirit this group chiselled out a well deserved victory to atone for their first round reversal to Inniscarra. Valleys got off to a good start registering three points to Castelyons one after 7 minutes. Valleys then missed a penalty and spurred on by this Castelyons added two more points to tie up scores at 3 points each after 12 minutes. This would break many a team but not our hurlers as they battled gamely and were rewarded by a Tadgh Burke goal on the 21st minute following great work from impressive 17 year old debutant Jason Crowley. The remainder of the half was evenly fought until added time when Kevin Canty ghosted in behind the Castelyons defence to score a vital goal to leave the half time score 2-04 to 0-05 in Valleys favour.

Castelyons rearranged their team in the second half and were scoring more freely in this half as a result but Valleys responded excellently when needed as shown by a great save from Valleys custodian Willie Burke to deny Castelyons what seemed like a certain goal when he found himself one on one with their corner forward shortly after half time. Kevin Canty got onto the end of a long ball into the square to dispatch superbly to the net on 45 mins to leave Valleys ahead 3-06 to 0-10.

Castelyons respond well in the last 15 mins but this goal, inspirational points from Jason Crowley, Kevin Canty and Eoin Manning plus some resolute defending kept Castelyons at bay for Valleys to record a 3-08 to 0-15 victory.
