## Reports

### Premier Intermediate football

Valley Rovers exited the Premier Intermediate football championship last Friday night in sun drenched Inniscarra. Valleys got off to a good start in this game with two excellent Fiachra Lynch points. Kiskeam responded well to go 4 points to two up after 14mins. Valleys hit back and the game was level at 5 points apiece after 25mins. Kiskeam were at this stage beginning to show that they had dangerous forwards and scored the next three points before half time. Valleys needed to have a strong start to the second half but it was Kiskeam that continued their good form from before the break and 6 minutes into the second half had extended their lead to 1-09 to 0-06 courtesy of an expertly taken penalty. Valleys had a 14minute barren spell in the second half where they failed to register a score despite having the lion's share of possession. With 5 mins to go Valleys were still behind by two goals when Fiachra Lynch conjured up an excellent goal. Valleys kept piling on the pressure but could not get the vital scores. Eoghan Delaney half chance in extra time flew over the bar and with that the final whistle sounded and our exit from the championship for 2012.

### Under 16 hurling

Valley Rovers under 16 hurlers had a hard fought victory over Charleville last Monday night in Blarney on a score of 15 points to 1 goal and 8. Valleys started the stronger with points from Darragh Looney, Eoin O Reilly, Stephen O Shea and Billy Crowley to lead by 4 points to 1 after ten minutes. Valleys dominated most of the possession around the middle of the field however Charleville's centre back was extremely strong in the air and stopped many an attack down the middle. Eoin O Reilly and

Darragh Looney's free taking was excellent throughout the evening which gave Valley's an 8 points to 4 lead approaching half time. At this point Charleville were awarded a penalty when Cormac Desmond was harshly penalised for a foul in the square. The penalty was excellently save by Cormac and Valleys eventually went into half time with a 9 points to 4 lead.

After half time valleys started very strongly to take a 7 point lead of 11 to 4 and appeared to be very much in control of the game. Charleville however began pressing very hard with strong running up the middle which eventually produced an excellent goal. Charleville added a further 4 point to valleys 1 over the next 10 minutes to leave the score 12 points to 1.8 with 5 minutes remaining. Chris O Leary was moved to full forward at this stage in an attempt to win possession in front of goal and immediately scored 2 valuable points, one after a great catch by Tadhg O'Brien in midfield from an excellent Joe Bernard puck out. The scoring was completed with a superb point from Darragh Looney out on the right wing to give Valleys a narrowly deserved win. The victory puts valleys into the county semi-final against the winners of Carrigaline and Youghal to be played on the 20th of August. The team and mentors would like to extend a special thanks to Danny O Sullivan who returned early from London, sacrificing the opportunity to watch Katie Taylor box live in the Olympics.
