Even though it was a eight point defeat for Valleys, this young and inexperienced team can take heart from their performance as they were up against a full strength Na Piarsaigh side preparing for the senior relegation final next weekend. Despite this Valleys were competitive in the first half and had the lion's share of possession through Chris O'Donovan and Eoin Manning but found it difficult to turn their possession into scores, Na Piarsaigh on the other hand were very efficient in front of goal. On the 16th Na Piarsaigh received a major boost when Valleys goalkeeper Terence Cronin could only get a small hand to a goal bound effort and the ball ended up in the roof of the net to leave the scoreline at halftime Valley's 0-03 to Na Piarsaigh 1-04. After the break Valleys were again very competitive and for a ten minute spell between the 40th and 50th minute kicked 1-02 without reply. However the problem for Valleys was the concession of two soft goals one at either side of this ten minute spell. Under 14 football League

Valley Rovers under 14 footballers completed their 2012 league fixtures in Brinny on Sunday, losing to Eire Og by 5-11 to 4-4. Played in difficult weather conditions, with periods of very heavy rain, against an Eire Og team that are top of the league table. The away team got off to a good start with a goal and a point in the first few minutes, before Adam Settini opened the Valley Rovers' scoring with point from a free. Over the next ten minutes Eire Og registered three points, but Rovers stayed in touch with a point by Colm Barry followed by a goal from full forward Sean O'Donovan. Rovers suffered a setback by conceding a penalty after 20 min which was sent to the back of the net, but ended the half with a goal by Adam Settini, leaving the score 3-5 to 2-2 at the HT.

Valley Rovers started the 2nd half very well with a point by substitute Olan Fehily and a goal by Colm Barry, while their opponents failed to record a score for ten minutes, leaving only two points between the teams. However, Eire Og dominated the last 20 min and went on to score 2-6 in that period, while Rovers only managed a late goal and a point. So, while it was disappointing to finish the league campaign with a defeat, Rovers were clearly up against strong opposition and again they played some good football at times despite the wet conditions. Given the relatively small panel of players available and the competitive nature of the Premier 2 league, the Rovers Under 14s acquitted themselves well overall in 2012. They have shown that they have plenty footballing ability, but there is definitely plenty scope for improvement, and more consistency. We look forward to building on this year's experience in 2013.
