## U15 Hurling County Final

Valley Rovers U15 hurlers contested the Premier 2 hurling County final in sunny Carrigaline on Sunday. Both sides had chances in the first 5 minutes, but it was Valleys who scored first when Aaron Lyons kicked the ball to the net in a goalmouth scramble. Unfortunately Killeagh / Itas response was swift when in the next passage of play their big full forward scored a great goal followed by 6 points. Killeagh / Itas were dominant in most sectors at this stage, but Valleys fought their way back, and dominated the last 15 minutes, scoring 1:4 to Killeagh / Itas 3 points. Chris O Leary scored 2 long range frees and a point from play. Colm Butler added another point before Aaron Lyons netted his second goal to leave Valleys trailing by 2 points at half time. Valleys had the first attack of the second half, but Killeagh / Itas cleared the sliothar up the field and scored a second goal, followed by 3 points. Chris O Leary responded with three from placed balls. Valleys had a few goal chances, but luck was not on our side. Killeagh / Itas scored another 2:04 to Valleys 4 points, before the end. Cathal Dart O Flynn and Sean O Regan got a point each from play in between 2 pointed frees from Chris O Leary and Eoin Burke. Gary Jones gets the man of the match award after some excellent saves.

This team were excellent in their last 3 championship matches, and were beaten by a more balanced team on a day when luck was not on our side. There has been a massive improvement in the quality and skill level of our play since the start of the year, and reaching the County Final was a great achievement.
