U15 Hurling County Final

Valley Rovers 3-8 Aghada 1-5

Valleys U15's bounced back from their defeat in the County Hurling Final, with a brilliant team performance to beat Aghada in the county semi final in Ballinure on Saturday last in the U15 Premier 2 County Football Semi Final, and booking a place in the County Final on Sunday next the 25th, where they will meet Ballincollig.

Valleys played with a slight breeze in the first half, but it was Aghada who scored first with a point from play.

Eoin Burke opened the scoring for Valleys with a close in free, followed by one from play by Adam Settini.

Valleys were working very hard and were rewarded when Aaron Lyons put the ball in the net with a well worked goal. 5 minutes later a high ball from Eoin Burke dropped into the Aghada net, to give Valleys a commanding lead. Aghada fought back with a goal and 2 points, but Valleys finished the half strongly with 2 points from Adam Settini and 1 from Mark Healy to leave Valleys leading by 5 points at the break.

Valleys started brightly in the second half with 2 points, one a free from Eoin Burke, and the other from play by Mark Healy. The game ended as a contest in the 18th minute when Tomas Sweetnam was brought down in the square for a penalty, and Eoin Burke dispatched the ball to the corner of the net, to leave Valleys leading by 10 points. Aghada did get a point back from a free, but Colm Butler did likewise at the other end. Aghada threw everything at the Valleys defence for the last 7 minutes, but Valleys held firm, only conceding 1 point before the final whistle to win by 9 points.

This was a superb team effort by all the lads. Best on the day were Andrew O Callaghan, Bill Casey, Adam Settini, Colm Butler and Tomas Sweetnam.

Ballincollig in the County Final next weekend will be a big challenge, but if the team can play as a unit like they did in this match, they will be in with a good chance.
