Reports

Minor Football Premier 1 Championship.

St Michaels 1-13 Valley Rovers 2-8

Valley Rovers Minor footballers had an agonising loss in their Premier 1 Round 1 Football Championship match against St. Michaels at CIT on Wednesday July 18th. Not having played a competitive football match with anything approaching a full squad since April meant that Valleys entered the match with some uncertainties about their best formation. Throughout, Michaels got a better return for their possession despite Valleys dominating large parts of the game. Valleys totally dominated the last 15 mins hitting the Michaels crossbar twice and kicking some poor wides. Michaels then came up the field to take the last score to put two between the teams at the finish. The wides count told its own story. Michaels kicked just 4 to Valleys 13.

The first half finished at 1-6 apiece. Highlights included two superb points from Luke Counihan running from deep and an Eoin Fallon goal where he ran from deep towards the Michaels goal and received a cross field pass from Derek Canty which he finished clinically to the net. Michaels were very efficient with the chances they got, but were fortunate enough to score a fisted goal from a free that rebounded off the post.

Valleys probably lost the game early in the second half when Michaels scored five consecutive points without reply. Derek Canty's move to centre forward sparked a Valleys revival and the team put some terrific moves together to create goal chances, one of which Canty dispatched himself to the net. At this point Valleys took over the play and dominated possession with Chris Harrington making excellent darting runs from wing back. The forwards as a unit displayed some great running and passing but didn't deliver on the scoreboard. A superb move led to Luke Counihan being fouled when he had a clear run on goal, Jason Crowley hit the crossbar at the end of another great move involving Eoin O' Reilly and Derek Canty. Finally, a brilliant Valleys move ended with Crowley through on goal. What looked like a perfect finish to the corner hit the underside of the bar and then the post and the chance was gone.

All-in-all the team was unlucky, but the intensity of a Premier 1 championship clash will stand to them for the rest of the season. They now go on to play Na Piarasigh, scheduled for August 2nd, but likely to change due to a fixtures glut. The Valleys Team was as follows:
