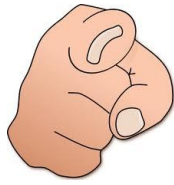

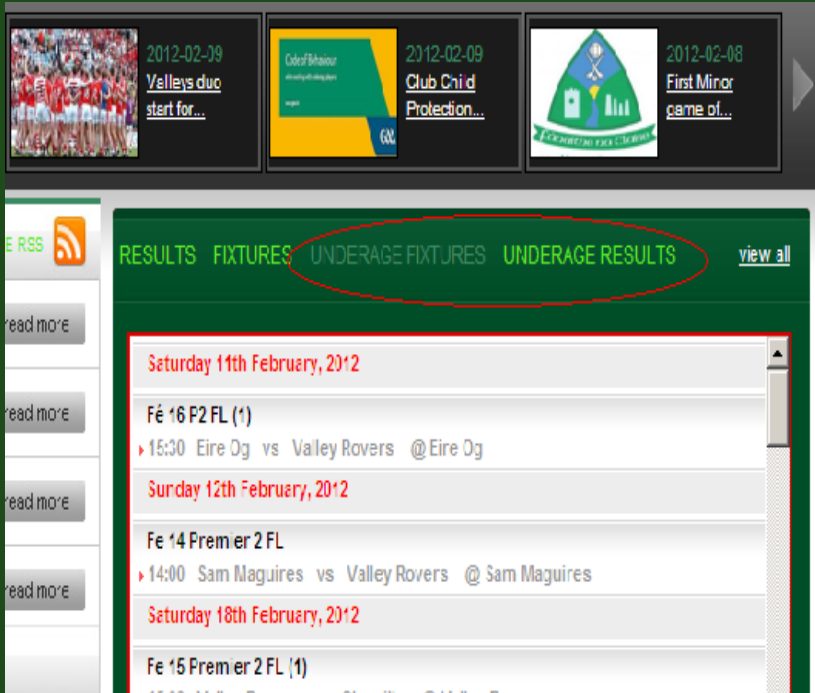
Communication Survey
