Workshop/Master Class Eligibility: These classes are designed to improve the technique and basic skills of pupils in the “Improvers and “Advanced” categories. They are confined to members of Comhaltas.

Class Fees: The fee for the day is €10.00 for one workshop and €15 for anyone doing both workshops. This fee includes Lunch (i.e. tea or mineral, sandwiches, snacks etc.)

Registration: While it is permissible for pupils to register on the Saturday morning at 10.30am, you are asked to note, that because of the limited size of the venues, a maximum of twenty will be accepted for each class, on a “first-come, first-served” basis. On Saturday morning, on arrival at Ceolann, please report to the meeting room and register your name. Positively, no spectators will be allowed at the classes.

Rialacha Na gComórtas

1. All instrumental and singing competitions are open to all competitors qualified by age, who have never won First, Second or Third prize on the particular instrument, or singing competition in any age group at a County Fleadh Cheoil or County Ceol an Gheimhridh, or the Open Lixnaw Féile Cheoil.
2. All competitions are open to Non-Members as well as Members of Comhaltas.
3. The competition Fee for all instrumental and singing competitions is €2.00 per person, and is payable to the clerk prior to competing. Copies of the adjudication sheet will be made available on the day.
4. Ages shall be reckoned as at 1st January 2018. Birth Certificates to be produced if requested by the Runaí.
5. In all Solo Competitions, competitors may compete in own age group only.
6. In U8 & U10 instrumental competitions, competitors must play one selection from the following: Jig (Single, Double, Slip or Slide); Reel; Hornpipe; Polka; Set Dance or Slow Air. In all other instrumental competitions, competitors must play two tunes.
7. In singing competitions, Under 12 one full song is required, Over 12 Two contrasting songs.
