

Requesting a Course

Basketballscotland organise many UKCC course in each across the country to meet the demand of its clubs and members. However, if you are a club or organisation and have enough candidates to fill a course (minimum 10, maximum 16) and depending on numbers you may request a closed course. You must request a course at least 2 months before the first day of the course.

Expectations of Club/Organisation

- You should have sourced a number of candidates interested in attending the course
- To run a closed course there should be at least 10 candidates
- You will be responsible for finding and paying for a venue to host the course, with at least one full basketball court and 10 basketballs
- A theory room with access to WiFi, a projector and white screen should also be provided
- The full course fees must be paid at least 14 days before the start of the course (*please do not apply for subsidy, this will be done by **basketballscotland** on your behalf*)
- To the best of your ability, try to identify a mentor for the candidates associated within the LA programme / associated clubs

Expectations of **basketballscotland**

- will advertise the course on the **basketballscotland** website and to local Clubs if necessary
- will provide a qualified professional tutor to deliver the course and an assessor for the exam
- will provide all course material and distribute to the candidates directly
- will administrate the course in full providing SQA certificates.
- will submit the subsidy application on behalf of all candidates.
