



## **St Maurs Development Some questions Answered**

### **What are we building ?**

A 135 x 85 M full size All weather pitch with 3 G surface, floodlights and fencing located on our current training pitch area. Further project phases are planned also, including a new sand based pitch to replace the poorly drained pitch nearest the clubhouse, a resurfacing of our ball wall, a warm up area and an overhaul of our clubhouse.

### **What stage are we at ?**

Planning permission has been submitted . With planning achieved we aim to go to tender in May and begin construction later this year with completion mid 2019

### **How will we fund it ?**

The funding will be a breakdown as follows 40% loan from Dublin co board, 25% grant aid, 35% fundraising & sponsorship. We have already secured a grant of 102,000 from the sports capital grants of 2017

### **How Do I donate ?**

Contact any of the names on the last page of the brochure. If you are a PAYE worker fill in the Tax relief form to help the club benefit from your tax.

If you wish to contribute by a regular standing order fill in the standing order form which will transfer money to the deicated club development account in the Progressive Credit Union

Return all forms in a sealed envelope to the club FAO the chairman or secretary of the club.

### **What If I can't afford €1000 ?**

We are happy to accept any level of donation. Any donation above €250 in one tax year qualifies for tax releife for the project

### **If I donate €1000 over two years or more will I still get my name on the patrons board ?**

Yes every supporter who donates €1000 will go on the board and all donations to the project will be acknowledged

### **What name will go on the patrons board ?**

The club will contact you directly to ask what name you wish on the board or if you want to remain anonymous

### **How soon will phase 2 begin ?**

We hope to begin work on phase 2 installation of a raised sand based pitch adjacent to the clubhouse as soon as the 3G pitch opens

The cost of this is significantly lower than the 3G pitch at around €200,000

### **Will the club fundraise also ?**

The club will only run its normal fundraising activity in 2018 namely our golf classic, race night and christmas draw as well as some smaller fundraisers. We may run a large scale fundraiser as we did in 2013 with strictly St Maurs for the later phases of development.
