



Memo To Hockey New Zealand Regions

Re: Hockey New Zealand Anti Match Fixing and Sports Betting Policy

Hockey New Zealand has developed a draft policy relating to Anti Match Fixing and Sports Betting. This policy will be in effect for the upcoming 2015 National Hockey League. To ensure all regions and the various Relevant Persons (as defined in the policy and summary) are aware of the new policy and the implications of the policy, HNZ is sharing the Policy and a summary of the policy to all regional CEO's, GM's or nominated representatives. We ask that the summary and if necessary, the Policy be read, understood and shared by all the regional Relevant Persons before the teams commence playing in the 2015 NHL. Where any doubt exists, we ask that you refer any questions to Hockey New Zealand for clarification.

To ensure the necessary information is widely disseminated, information will also be provided to the tournament director, and to team managers/delegates at the tournament management meeting. We ask that the information be shared widely across each region and associations. The summary was developed as a resource that would be shared with coaches, athletes, support staff and any other individuals identified as a Relevant Person. If deemed necessary, the full Policy could also be provided to ensure that any clarification needed was available for any individual seeking additional information.

Please read the information carefully, and confirm directly with Terry Evans (High Performance Director, Hockey New Zealand) or Malcolm Harris (Chief Executive Officer Hockey New Zealand) that you have read and understood all the information contained within the summary and if necessary, the Policy. Please also confirm that the necessary information will be passed on to each of the Relevant Persons as outlined in the summary and Policy document.
