DISPENSATION POLICY

**Taken From RA Rules & Regulations:**

## **1. JURISDICTION**

1.3 Variations to these rules and regulations applicable to Junior Rugby are established by Alberta Minor Rugby (refer to [www.albertajuniorrugby.com](http://www.albertajuniorrugby.com)).

## **2. PLAYER ELIGIBILITY**

2.1 All players wishing to play rugby under the jurisdiction of Rugby Alberta, the Edmonton Rugby Union or the Calgary Rugby Union must not less than 24 hours prior to the commencement of play have registered with Rugby Alberta, by completing a Rugby Canada Registration and Waiver Form supplied to all clubs.

2.2 Only a player who is currently registered with Rugby Alberta, the Edmonton Rugby Union or the Calgary Rugby Union shall be able to participate in competitions organized, recognized or Sanctioned by that union. A player may not be registered simultaneously with more than one union. The union with which he/she is registered shall determine the status of a player.

(ALBERTA JUNIOR RUGBY IS ALSO CLASSED AS A UNION AND HAS ITS OWN JURISDICTION OVER PLAYERS)  
A PLAYER CANNOT BE REGISTERED TO THE ALBERTA JUNIOR RUGBY ASSOCIATION AND PLAY SENIOR RUGBY AT THE SAME TIME UNLES THE CORRECT DISPENSATION AND TRANSFER HAS BEEN APPROVED.

## **DEFAULTS**

12.3 A club shall be considered to have defaulted a game in the following circumstances.

iv. A team plays an ineligible player as defined by these Rules and Regulations
