Objective:

With guidance from the Director of Rugby, the primary role of the head coach is to select, coach and prepare the provincial team to perform, enhancing the reputation of Rugby Alberta as a leader in player development.

Key Tasks and Responsibilities:

- To create and foster an innovative environment that is game-based, player-centered, which promotes mutual accountability between coaches and players.
- Lead in the development and foster an environment that is based on respect and empathy.
- Lead talent identification at the Alberta Regional Competition (ARC).
- Chair selection meetings with regional coaches at ARC.
- Help develop and foster an environment that stimulates and promotes optimal levels of player development with a focus on skill development.
- Ensure the safety and welfare of all players in coaching sessions.
- Keep abreast of all game law changes ensuring players have an understanding and respect for the laws of the game.
- Conduct analysis of individual players, team and the opposition with use of video when available.
- Accept and coordinate the involvement of the Director of Rugby, skills coaches and specialized coaches as and when deemed advantageous to the team.
- Lead and coordinate management team to ensure players receive quality feedback and lines of communication are opened with regional, club and school coaches.
- Lead the team selection with assistant coach and support staff.
- Provide technical and tactical coaching to individual players, mini-units and the team in line with the "The Alberta Way" principles.
- Advocate on behalf of the players promoting their ability to be selected for higher honors where appropriate.
- Be a key leader in developing and promoting Rugby Alberta.
