What is the Commitment to Rugby Fair Play Policy

Alberta Rugby Football Union (Rugby Alberta) is a sporting organization that greatly values competitive spirit and fair play. In order to encourage the highest possible standard of conduct from its members, Rugby Alberta has developed the following set of Fair Play Guidelines. Our Board of Directors and staff will lead by example, presenting as good role models and communicating with members in a courteous manner to help create a positive sporting environment. Our Union encourages players, spectators, coaches and officials to reinforce the principles of fair play - respect, integrity and fairness. We understand that children learn from adults, and our behaviour reflects what we want children to learn. We understand that the biggest reason for players and officials quitting the game is abuse. We understand that players, coaches and officials are learning the game, and mistakes will be made in the learning process. We understand that officials are responsible to ensure that the game is played in a safe and fair manner for all participants.
