BIDDING ON MAJOR EVENTS

Adopted 1997

Major events are very important to Alberta Rugby as they:

1. Increase the visibility of our sport.
2. Provide the opportunity for our rep. programs to showcase their talent.
3. Can be significant money makers for Alberta Rugby.
4. Build relationships for reciprocal tours.

Major events could be a major club tour, a Canadian regional or national championship or an International game. These games are usually awarded to Alberta by Rugby Canada. The Executive Director would then determine interest.

Location of the event will be determined on a bid basis. Consideration will be given to:

- A) field and venue costs
- B) availability of needed items such as change rooms, parking lots, banquet facility etc

Attempts will be made to move events north and south provided venues are available  
Rugby Alberta will make the final decision as to where an event will be hosted.

The ARU will review the written bids and, using the criteria set down above, award the game.

Should ARU decide that another group should be able to host an event awarded to Alberta, that host will need to compensate ARU an agreed upon fee.

The group awarded a major event must copy the ARU office on all correspondence and provide monthly progress reports to the ARU.
