Dear Parents & Spectators,

As we move into the ARC Sevens weekend, please make sure that you are aware of the following items prior to your arrival at Foote Field. For those of you who are unable to make their way up to Edmonton, all ARC games will be live-streamed on our Rugby Alberta Facebook page, be sure to get on our social media pages to stay updated.

Facility Address:

- The address for the Foote Field Dome is: 11601 68 Avenue NW, Edmonton AB T6G 2E1

Parking:

- There is limited parking in the lot directly outside the dome. However, there are multiple parking lots at the surrounding buildings that will be open for event parking. There is also a larger lot outside the Saville Centre that is available for use. If you park outside the Saville Centre, you will need to make your way through the building to get to the Dome field, the Saville staff will be able to direct you.

Gate:

- Admission is \$10/day per person
- The gate will not open until **7:30 AM** both days. If you arrive early, please be prepared to wait until 7:30 to gain access to the dome.
- All spectators will get a stamp upon admittance and will be free to come and go by presenting the stamp at the gate.

Dome Rules & Capacity:

- The capacity of the dome is set at 300 people for various safety regulations. There will be security personnel manning the gate and ensuring that we do not go over the capacity limit.
- If the Dome reaches capacity, all remaining spectators and parents will be directed to the Multi-Purpose room until admission can be resumed. Games will be live-streamed in the Multi – Purpose room, all are welcome to come and go as they please from this room.
- Please be sure to adhere to all signage and directions regarding spectator/parent areas and players only areas.
- Players will be asked to exit the dome area between games.
- Roasti Coffee vendor will be on-site to cater to all your coffee needs. If you are bringing any other liquids into the Dome, please ensure they are in a travel mug or water bottle.

Fair Play:

- A friendly reminder to all spectators, parents, coaches and players to foster a positive environment by adhering to the Rugby Alberta Code of Conduct and our Key Principles of safety, integrity, respect and inclusion for all.
