In the Premier 1 U-15 hurling league at Ballyanly on Saturday Inniscarra had an impressive win over Bishopstown. Playing against the wind in the first half Inniscarra were slow to get going but a good early save from goalkeeper Pdraig Holland settled them. Bishopstown scored first but an impressive full back line of Evan Kelly, Brian Linehan and the dependable Cillian Murphy at full back prevented further scores. Owen McCarthy pointed for Inniscarra after a fine run from Dylan Church and then goaled after good work from the hard working Eddie O'Connor. Con O'Leary was superb at centre back with Jamie O'Sullivan also impressing to keep Inniscarra in control. Owen McCarthy had another point before Dylan Church set up Sean Geary for a goal before scoring a point himself. Frankie Horgan then hit a purple patch scoring two great points and a further point from Owen McCarthy had the score at half time
