## Minor Football County Semi-Final

Evening Echo Report Saturday Sep 17, 2016, Barry O'Mahony

Bishopstown 3-8 Valley Rovers 3-7

A late Conor Hegarty point sealed Bishopstown's passage into the Premier 2A Minor Football Final following an entertaining win over Valley Rovers at Ovens last night. In a topsy-turvy game, where both sides had their period of dominance, it was Bishopstown who held their nerve in the closing stages to progress. The winners started the better, with three points inside nine minutes, Brian O'Neill's effort the highlight after a nice pass by Kevin Barry. Valleys had five wides inside ten minutes, before hitting 1-2 in four minutes, Rory O'Sullivan with the goal. It was 1-2 to 0-3 after 17 minutes. It was now Bishopstown's turn to take over, with 2-1 in four minutes, O'Neill and Colm O'Driscoll the goal scorers. Valleys finished the half strongly with two points from Adam Settini and Robert-Sean Sweetnam: 2-4 to 1-4 at halftime. Despite conceding an early point, Valleys responded with 1-1 in a 60-second spell to level the game, Sweetnam with the goal after a scramble in the box. The winners nudged ahead with an O'Neill point, 2-6 to 2-5 with 15 minutes remaining. The Innishannon side then looked to have the bit between their teeth, as they led 3-6 to 2-6, with 12 minutes remaining after hitting 1-1, O'Sullivan with his second goal. Bishopstown then went one ahead after scoring 1-1 in two minutes, Dara Costello with a crucial goal. Valleys levelled with two minutes left, as Cathal Manning sent over a gem of a point. With the game deadlocked, it was Hegarty who was the hero for Bishopstown, as he was on the end of a neat move to send over the winning point in the 59th minute.
