Senior B Camogie County Final

Valley Rovers 1-7 to Mallow 2-6

Valley Rovers Senior girls played Mallow in the Senior B county final yesterday in Castle Road, Valleys opened the scoring after two minutes through a Connie Hawkes point from play Mallow opened their account after nine minutes with a well executed goal. This game was played at a high tempo as expected and after fifteen minutes a long range shot from Connie Hawkes found the back of the mallow net to put Valley Rovers back into the lead by the narrowest of margins before mallow replied with two points from play before Susan O'Leary opened her account with just moments remaining in the first half to level the game. However Mallow were rewarded for their dominance when a long range free wasn't dealt with by the Valleys defence resulting in Mallow finding the net to leave the half-time score Valley Rovers 1-2 Mallow 2-2.

On the resumption Mallow continued to pressurise the Valleys defence and added two further points to give them a five point lead, before Lisa Lynch pointed from distance after seven minutes of the second half. In the following fifteen minutes both teams added a brace of point, Susan O'Leary pointing twice from played balls to leave four points between them with five minutes left. Valleys began to play their best hurling as time ran out and points from Orla Deasy & Elma O' Mahony had the deficit down to two with normal time up. However good defensive work by Mallow forcing Valleys into difficult scoring angles meant that Mallow held on to be deserving winners on the day on a score line of Valley Rovers 1-7 Mallow 2-6. 

Bandon struck back soon after with a goal of their own, but the girls did not panic and with Orla O'Sullivan beginning to dominate around the half forward line, Valleys added to their tally with another goal and a point from Caoimhe McCarthy.

An unfortunate injury meant Orla O'Sullivan had to leave the field but Aisling O'Donovan took over her role and added another point, and then a flowing move, that started in the full back line, saw Ellie O'Sullivan hit the back of the net an just before half time. Caoimhe McCarthy added another point to leave the score 3-3 – 1-0 at the break.

The second half started in the same manner as the first half, but with Laoise Collins in midfield, Kate and Molly Lynch in the back line and the impressive Niamh Crowley and Claire Flynn at half back beginning to dominate, Valleys were rewarded with a further goal by Caoimhe McCarthy and point by Aisling O'Donovan. 
