## Head Coach

The New Haven Old Black Rugby Football Club has an established core of players that has already qualified for the spring 2019 Empire Conference Playoffs based off of a 7-1 fall league record. The team has goals of winning the Empire Championship and making a run at a national title.

The spring season will run from the first week of February through the first week of June (depending on performance in the playoffs). Winter indoor training generally takes place twice a week in the evenings (depending on availability). Outdoor training usually runs on Tuesday and Thursday evenings from 6:30pm to 8:00pm in New Haven.

Compensation: A monthly stipend will be provided as well as travel reimbursement for games/tournaments. Housing accommodations may be provided.
