 - Includes working knowledge of NERFU League and Match Play Rules
- ❖ Enthusiastic Commitment to the Club and its Players:
 - Ability to Create Vision, Development, and Implementation of Short-and-Long-Term Club Growth Strategy
 - Plan and Develop Short-and-Long-Term Recruitment and Retention Strategy
 - Mentor and advise Coaching Staff and Players, where appropriate
 - Develop Sustainable Culture of Accountability and Competitiveness
 - Challenge Players and Maintain their Sustained Engagement in the Program
- ❖ Organization of Training Session and Match Game Plans
- ❖ Ensure that all Sessions are Designed to Develop the Skills and Understanding of the Players
- ❖ Evaluate all Coaching Sessions and Matches with Coaching Staff and Players
- ❖ Ability to Effectively Communicate with Coaching Staff, Captain, and Players
 - Including maintenance of open communication with Assistant Coaches and Captain regarding Selection
