Requirements:

- USA Rugby Certification or willing to achieve before Autumn season.
- Rugby playing experience
- Flexibility on practice and game days
- Ability to build a solid DIII club that is sustainable
- Ability to plan 2 focused trainings a week (usually Tuesday and Thursday nights)
- Ability to provide instruction and encouragement to players of all skill levels
- Understand the skillset of the players and create a game plan to suit those abilities
- Manage fair playing time among "A" and "B" teams
- Keep the practices challenging, engaging, and fun
- Work with team captains to continually improve practices and provide feedback to players
