NOTICE:

- This year's event will be held on 24th February, 2018 at Gormanston College, Gormanston, Co. Meath.
- All players and coaches must be registered with Volleyball Ireland to take part in the tournament.
- New players and coaches can register for a team by completing the "Non-League Player Registration Form", available at the following link: <u>VI Non-League Player Registration</u> <u>Form</u>. Registrations can only be processed if accompanied by relevant signature(s), full payment and passport photo (electronic format accepted).
- All players and coaches will be required to produce their registration cards or Photo ID for each match.
- It is the responsibility of the individual club to ensure that each team list is up to date this will be checked at the event.
- Teams and players are able to participate in the Championships AND the mixed recreational tournament matches will be scheduled so that they don't clash.
- The final format of the competition is at the discretion of the Competitions Commission.
- Gormanston College is accessible by car off the M1 motorway (exit 6), more details available at: Gormanston College contact details & directions
- Depending on costs and interest, Volleyball Ireland may organise a bus from Dublin city centre to the venue. This would run once a day to the venue in the morning and back at the end of the day and the cost would be borne by those travelling on the bus. Please indicate your interest on the form and the number of people who would travel on the bus from your club/team and those who are not participating in the Volleyball Ireland Championships.
- Gormanston College is also accessible by Bus Eireann bus (route 101 approximately 1 hr 20 minutes from Dublin city centre – bus stop: Old Huntsman Inn and then a 10 minute walk) and by mainland train from Dublin Connolly (Gormanston College is located 2km from the train station via back roads so caution advised).
